They could also participate in a walking tour of downtown Reading PA on Friday, which Conrad helped found in 1748 and lay out and where he had an early trading store.

Weiser descendants could also tour Historic Trappe, which has strong ties to the family of Conrad's daughter Anna Maria and her husband Henry Melchior Muhlenberg, an important early leader in the Lutheran Church in the American colonies.

Planning and holding a reunion to help family members get better acquainted, share family information, and learn more about the family's heritage is a great way to expand your family's genealogical awareness and build your family trees.

Next summer Paulette will attend another Weiser family reunion in south central North Dakota of the descendants of her paternal grandparents who farmed there. Those reunions have been held every five years since 1963!
